Heimaey | Iceland

Heimaey rises triumphantly from the sea. The largest of the 18 Westman Islands, Heimaey was born from volcanoes and has a history as rocky as it is intriguing. In January 1973, Heimaey's Eldfell volcano erupted, forcing the evacuation of the entire island and burying 400 homes and buildings with rocks and lava. Today, the eastern portion of Heimaey is an archaeological excavation site known as the "Pompeii of the North." As you discover Heimaey, thrill to its fantasy-like landscape. Enjoy vistas of jagged cliffs, stunning caves and unique rock formations, as well as remarkable vegetation that supports a variety of sea and bird life. The village is also home to the world's largest puffin colony during the summer months. In fact, every summer, children rescue thousands of lost baby pufflings and bring them to the local Sæheimar Aguarium where they are cared for and re-released into the world.

Reykjavik | Iceland

Welcome to Earth's northernmost capital! Nestled between panoramic mountains and the turquoise Atlantic Ocean, Reykjavik offers



an impressive portrait of lava fields, craters, waterfalls and imposing mountains. The cosmopolitan town has a pedestrian-friendly center with classy restaurants, pubs and cozy cafes; a host of museums, exhibition spaces and art galleries; and the breathtaking Hallgrímskirkja church. Vast geothermal pots located throughout the city provide residents with hot water used for heating homes, filling public pools and creating the mineral-rich waters of the Blue Lagoon. You might choose to visit the Fontana Spa and Wellness Center for a mind and body indulgence amid thermal steam baths. Another option is to discover Iceland's stunning Golden Circle sightseeing route, a treat for the eyes!

Ísafjörður | Iceland

Imagine an unspoiled wilderness where dramatic fjords slice through sheer mountains and expansive forests give way to flowerbedecked meadows. First settled by Viking Helgi Hrolfsson in the ninth century, Ísafjörður retains its charming, authentic character. The Old Town boasts18th-century buildings that harken to the days when tall ships and whaling crews crowded the harbor. Along with its rich Viking sagas and legends, Ísafjörður flaunts a thriving arts scene and innovative food culture. Optional excursions include visiting a traditional countryside farm or an avian sanctuary on Vigur Island.

Akureyri | Iceland

Akureyri, Iceland's second city, is snuggled against a spectacular backdrop of volcanic mountains and the Glerá River. Along with a friendly pedestrian street flanked by inviting cafes, Akureyri has two unique landmarks: the towering Akureyrarkirkja church with a model ship suspended from its ceiling and the Akureyri Botanical Garden, which provides a retreat for nature lovers. Join an optional excursion to the beautiful waters of Eyjafjörður fjord to see minke, blue, fin and humpback whales, as well as dolphins and porpoises, or climb aboard a plane for a breathtaking flight to remote Grimsey Island.

Húsavík | Iceland

This small fishing community in Skjálfandi Bay has garnered a well-deserved reputation as one of the world's best whale-watching destinations. Over 23 different species of whale have been recorded in these waters. Look for the inquisitive minke whale, Iceland's most visible and popular whale species. Other Icelandic favorites include migratory humpback whales, who captivate their audience by dramatically breaching the water's surface. and orcas, the largest member of the dolphin family. Observing these amazing mammals in their natural environment is a once-in-a-lifetime experience! Húsavík is also a cultural hub known for its delicious seafood, creative local art and fascinating museums. The Húsavík Whale Museum is especially notable.

Seyðisfjörður | Iceland

Seyðisfjörður, a quirky, beguiling enclave, is nestled on Iceland's eastern coast amid breathtaking snow-capped mountains. Built on the back of the Icelandic herring fishing industry, there's nowhere on Earth quite as picturesque or peaceful. A rainbow of 19th-century wooden buildings pepper the town center, while the famed Blue Church, with its distinct powder-blue hue, remains one of Iceland's most iconic landmarks. Listen to the bizarre Tvísöngur sound sculpture, a series of five concrete domes embedded into the mountainside above the town, or join an optional excursion to enjoy Seyðisfjörður's delightful waterfalls.



Sustainable Iceland

Iceland's unique geography, a vivid canvas of volcanoes, hot springs, geysers and snow-capped mountains, is not only visually thrilling but it also features a wealth of hydro- and geothermal resources. By harnessing the power of these clean, renewable energy sources, Icelanders have eliminated their dependence on fossil fuels for heating and electricity to become a world leader in sustainable energy development and greenhouse gas reduction.

Iceland is located above the Mid-Atlantic Ridge, an active volcano zone. Due to the shifting tectonic plates along the ridge, heat and magma are pushed from the Earth's core toward the surface in the form of steam. Icelanders capture the released steam, or "geothermal water," and use it for electricity, heat and hot water. In fact, nine out of 10 homes are heated with this geothermal energy!

While geothermal energy is used to heat houses, power greenhouses that produce the majority of the country's produce, heat swimming pools and warm snowy streets, the majority of Iceland's energy comes from hydropower plants. Water from glaciers and rivers is stored in dams. When released, the force of this moving water spins powerful turbines, producing an abundance of renewable electricity.

Reykjavik has set a goal to be absolutely free of fossil fuels by 2050.
