PRAGUE | PASSAU, GERMANY



• Highlights of Budapest. This capital was once two cities — Buda and Pest — on opposite sides of the Danube. Visit Heroes' Square, the Opera House and the Gothic-style Parliament Building. Enjoy stunning views of the Danube from Fisherman's Bastion.



- Living Local. Take a guided tour of Budapest's 19th-century Great Market Hall. Continue to a local coffee house to learn how pastry chefs craft the tastiest strudels. Enjoy a piece of strudel and a sampling of palinka, Eastern European popular schnapps.




