



DAY THREE

HONFLEUR

Excursion: *Historic Honfleur.* Get to know your home-away-from-home of Honfleur as you stroll the narrow streets of its town center, nestled against a striking 17th-century harbor. Bask in the scene that has inspired artists, writers and musicians for centuries. Visit the Old Port, imagining the explorers such as Samuel de Champlain who launched their voyages from Honfleur. Then see the wooden 15th-century Church of Sainte-Cathérine, built to resemble the upturned hull of a ship, and other historic landmarks.

Local Flavor: Lunch on specialties of the region at a Honfleur restaurant.

Independent Exploration: The afternoon is yours to relax or explore in Honfleur.

Educational Focus: *D-Day and the Battle of Normandy.* The region's proud and colorful history has deeply influenced the development of France, Great Britain and Western civilization. Discuss the role Normandy and its people played in this critical moment of the Allied war effort.

DAY FOUR

MONT SAINT-MICHEL

Excursion: *Le Mont Saint-Michel.* With one glimpse of Mont Saint-Michel's silhouette rising above the flat, white sands that surround the granite outcrop where the sanctuary church sits, you'll know why this UNESCO World Heritage





site is considered a wonder of the Western world. The abbey's first church was built in the eighth century, and construction progressed over the years, juxtaposing many architectural styles. Visit the island sanctuary church that, over the last millennium, has also served as a monastery, fortress and prison.

Local Flavor: During the excursion, enjoy lunch at a restaurant on the island.

DAY FIVE B

HONFLEUR

ELECTIVE | Excursion and **Educational Focus:** *Impressions of* Giverny and Rouen. Visit the colorful home of master impressionist Claude Monet in Giverny. Step inside Monet's bright studio and meander through the gardens that inspired his "Water Lilies" series. Discover Normandy's legacy as the cradle of impressionism. Consider how the region's light and landscape inspired the movement's artists. Continue to the Musée des Impressionnismes to view works by artists Monet influenced and enjoy lunch in the museum's garden café. Then, travel to Rouen, the city where Joan of Arc was imprisoned in 1430, to see the Gothic cathedral featured in Monet's works. See the Gros Horloge, a 14thcentury astronomical clock.

DAY SIX

D-DAY BEACHES

Excursion: *D-Day and the Battle of Normandy.* Take an emotional journey along the beaches of the Calvados coastline, the theater for Operation Overlord, one of history's most complex and important military ventures.

Normandy & D-Day

On June 6, 1944, despite mounting challenges, a heroic formation of Allied troops achieved the largest coordinated military invasion in world history on the beaches of Normandy, triggering the beginning of the end of World War II. Gen. Dwight D. Eisenhower's troops faced heavy resistance and saw thousands of casualties, but they succeeded in securing the beaches and marching on to Paris to free France from German control. As both a tactical and a psychological blow to Hitler and his troops, D-Day will forever be remembered as the moment of World War II when the tide began to turn against the Nazis.


Visit the vast Normandy American Cemetery, gain historical context at the Arromanches D-Day Museum and reflect at somber Omaha Beach and the Les Braves memorial.

Local Flavor: During the excursion, enjoy lunch at a nearby restaurant. Dinner is served at a restaurant at Honfleur's scenic harbor.

DAY SEVEN B | L

BAYEUX I CAEN

Excursion: *Bayeux*. Marvel at the Bayeux Tapestry. Treasured for both its artistic and historic value, it tells the story of the 1066 Battle of Hastings, which marks its 950th anniversary in 2016. The battle changed the course of history by giving victor William the Conqueror, Duke of Normandy, control of England. This battle is so significant and the stitched retelling of it so masterful that the tapestry is one of the top attractions in Normandy. Continue to Notre Dame Cathedral,



which features a mix of Romanesque and Gothic architecture.

Local Flavor: Stop for lunch at a restaurant. **Excursion:** Caen. Visit the Caen Peace Memorial, regarded as the premier World War II museum in France. Dedicated to peace, the museum's exhibits explore the impact of World War II into the present day.

Local Flavor: Visit a distillery and orchard to learn the heritage of Calvados, the region's beloved brandy distilled from cider. Sample and sip in an idyllic setting.

Educational Focus: *The French Resistance.* Discuss the origins and leaders of the French resistance to the Nazi occupation of France, the role of French patriots in the preparation for D-Day and the heroic efforts of French service members.
