Discovery

Beaune. Experience the captivating ambience of Beaune during a walking tour. Stroll the town's cobbled streets, passing ramparts, inviting squares and intimate cafes. Visit the 15th-century Hôtel-Dieu, or the Hospices de Beaune, a Gothic-style building recognized for its extravagant, colorful roof. The hotel is now the headquarters for Burgundy's charity wine auction, hosted in Beaune since 1859. Cap off your excursion with a delicious tasting of Beaune wines.

Benedictine Abbey of Cluny. These exceptional ruins are all that remain of one of the greatest religious buildings in the Christian world. Founded in 910 by William I the Pious, construction was completed in the mid-12th century and today the ruins stand tribute to the inimitable grandeur of the settlement.

Avignon. Take a walking tour through Avignon, a walled city nestled on the banks of the Rhône River. This lovely city is home to many remarkable buildings, including the Chapelle de l'Oratoire and the Saint-Agricol Church. Visit the Palace of the Popes, exploring the staterooms and the papal apartments.

Arles. Extraordinary Roman and Romanesque monuments fill this special city. The ancient amphitheater Les Arènes testifies to the city's prestige within the Roman Empire. Other highlights include the ruins of the Baths of Constantine, the Place du Forum and Cathedral of St.Trôphime.

Camargue Nature Park. Discover the river delta of the Camargue Natural Park, a UNESCO designated biosphere home to pink flamingos, white egrets, herons and more. Along the way, guides share their knowledge about this extraordinary area.
