1. How to download the Zoom application?

1) You may download the Zoom application before the event from <u>here</u>.

You can also download the application while you join your first Zoom meeting. The application will be downloaded automatically. If not, click "download & run Zoom" in the bottom of the page.

2. How to join a Meeting?

1) You should have received an email invitation for the event. You may simply click the URL Join Zoom Meeting link from the invitation. You may also dial the number to join the meeting.



Please click **Open Zoom Meetings** if you see the system dialog.

If nothing prompts from browser, click here to launch the meeting, or download & run Zoom.

3) Click "Join with Computer Audio."



3. How do I turn my audio/video on and off?

Make sure all other programs that utilize the camera are closed. Then, you can turn on and off your audio/video by clicking "Mute/Unmute" and "Start Video /Stop Video" from the lower left corner of the screen.



4. How do I rename myself?

1) Click on the "Participants" icon at the bottom of the window.



5. What are the differences between Zoom Meeting and Zoom Webinar?

Most of our events will be held via **Zoom Webinar**. As an attendee in **Zoom Webinar**, you will only see the host and the speaker view. You will join in listen-only mode. Others in the Webinar will not be able to see you. You cannot unmute yourself, only the host can mute/unmute your audio.

Zoom meetings are more interactive sessions. Participants can mute/unmute, start video/stop video from the lower left corner of the screen anytime during the meeting. We will be using Zoom Meeting for class reunions only.
